
<u>Emergency contact information</u> – Please ensure your emergency contact information listed in the office has current phone numbers and names. Forms are on the back table in the clubhouse and available in the office.

During the office hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, the double glass doors are unlocked. All doors in the clubhouse lock behind you automatically after 4:00 p.m. when the clubhouse doors are locked by the staff. At all times, you will need your key to access the doors on the pool deck that lead to the restrooms.

Rentals / FSBO – Background checks are required for all prospective homeowners AND renters. Per the prospectuses in the park, homeowners that sell their home "by owner" or rent their home must have the prospective buyers or renters approved by park management before contracts are signed. Renters must be registered with the office. Forms are available in the office for this purpose. Please call the office if you have questions about this policy.

Make that change you've been talking about! We offer a referral fee to those owners that refer friends and family that results in the purchase of one of our listed properties. 



hosted by Phil and Mary Ann Godin. There will be more information as the month progresses, and I'm sure more activities will be planned throughout the summer.


