#### **President's Letter**

At last, the back gate power was turned on. A few days later than we were hoping for but, the power came on as we were leaving the park for our men's luncheon Wednesday, March 8. That afternoon, Dave Storey and I put the bars in place and cycled the actuators to see how everything worked. We found the two mechanisms were not in sync and didn't know how to correct it. The electrician came the next day and corrected that. We then found that one needed a new drive belt, and both needed new back-up batteries that open the gates if there is a power failure. We are now waiting for a gate servicing company to correct those items. In the interim, at least the entrance and sign lights are operating from dusk to dawn. I hesitate to say AGAIN that everything will be operable by the time this letter is published, but ....

There is noticeable enthusiasm over the continued improvements to the park infrastructure. The streetlamp poles are being painted, the speed bumps have been painted, new flowers and plants are being put in place around the clubhouse and the mailboxes. Spanish moss has been removed from the trees near the clubhouse allowing them to sprout new leaves. The card room has had repairs made to a water-damaged wall and has been repainted. On Friday, March 10 a crew of HOA members put lattice around the bottom of our two sheds near the tennis courts. All of this has been done by our park maintenance crew with some help from HOA volunteers. What a cooperative effort. Thanks to everyone who has participated.

Fifty of our ladies left for a one-week cruise on Saturday, March 11. They filled most of the seats on the bus, and their luggage filled most of the space on the lower deck.

Our annual Volunteer's luncheon will be Wednesday, March 29 about the same time that our April newsletter comes out. Thanks to Dawn and Al Siems for putting it together.

In closing I am happy to report that our paid membership now stands at 186. That's fifty-three percent of the park.

Together as a team we have the goal to re-beautify Veranda Springs and make it the park we can all be proud of. Please be patient, as we have a lot of work to do.

#### I have a few reminders for residents.

Lot rent is due on the 1st, and you have a 4 day grace period till the 5th.

Our home office has notified us that any rent check received after the 5th must be charged a late fee, and further action could be taken.

# Sunshine Report

No news to report this month.

#### From the Management:

<u>Reminder:</u> Please DO NOT put your garbage bag by the curb without putting the bag into a can with a lid. We've had vultures, crows, and rats get into these bags by the curb in the last few weeks and your neighbors are complaining!

<u>Emergency contact information</u> – Please ensure your emergency contact information listed in the office has current phone numbers and names. Forms are on the back table in the clubhouse and available in the office.

During the office hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, the double glass doors are unlocked. All doors in the clubhouse lock behind you automatically after 4:00 p.m. when the clubhouse doors are locked by the staff. At all times, you will need your key to access the doors on the pool deck that lead to the restrooms.

Rentals / FSBO – Background checks are required for all prospective homeowners AND renters. Per the prospectuses in the park, homeowners that sell their home "by owner" or rent their home must have the prospective buyers or renters approved by park management before contracts are signed. Renters must be registered with the office. Forms are available in the office for this purpose. Please call the office if you have questions about this policy.

Home Resale's – Our resale homes are listed on the Mobile Home Village website! If you've been thinking of buying or selling a home in the park, now is the time! Make that change you've been talking about! We offer a referral fee to those owners that refer friends and family that results in the purchase of one of our listed properties. 

The Southeastern Guide Dog Walkathon at Nathan Benderson Park in Sarasota was a big success Saturday, March 4, with


several attending from Veranda Springs.
