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President's Letter

By now I'm sure most are aware of the election results for the HOA Board. New board members are: Jan Fetterly-Vice President; Albert Johnson-Secretary; and Fred Crider and Al Siems, Members-at-Large. Dennis McCarthy, Pat Dewitt, and I retained our past positions.

Changing the HOA fiscal year to the calendar year was passed unanimously.

There has been some reported consternation among some female residents about an all-male board. However, most of the ballots cast were by females so I have confidence that everyone will be fairly represented.

The encouraging thing about this election is that 80.6 percent of the paid members voted. Another recent encouragement is that, as of our February 9th coffee hour, we reached 178 paid HOA members for 2023. That means we now have 50.9 percent of the park represented by the Board.

By the time you read this the back gate should be operational. The electricians are scheduled to do their part February 16. The county is scheduled to inspect on February 17. FPL has a project scheduling system that will put their completion about two weeks later. So, by early March, the gate should be back in service. FINALLY!

We have discussed trying to have a Saturday coffee hour for those who can't make the regular one. There doesn't appear to be a way to do this that produces a positive result. My recommendation is for those who really want this to get together and set it up to suit. I will make myself available to attend and report the highlights of the regular meeting.

Laura Fallin and her very productive crew have replaced stop signs, speed limit signs, and have repainted a significant amount of the infra-structure. Their efforts are very noticeable, welcomed and appreciated.

When it's time for me to write my next letter, many of our snow birds will have already left or be planning to leave soon there-after. You'll be missed. Please travel safely.

Just a reminder (Suggestion) to our residents that leave for the summer:

<u>Emergency contact information</u> – Please ensure your emergency contact information listed in the office has current phone numbers and names. Forms are on the back table in the clubhouse and available in the office.
